



--- Things to Bring for Dorm Living ---

- Our dorm apartments are furnished (living room furniture, dining set, twin bunk beds, desks, and bookshelves and each apartment kitchen is furnished with a refrigerator, a stove/oven, and a microwave). However, you must provide your own dishes, silverware, cutlery, bowls, cookware, small appliances (i.e. coffee maker, toaster), etc.
- Bedding: you'll want to bring bedding for a twin-sized mattress (including a mattress pad).
- Towels, washcloths.
- Bath and personal hygiene supplies (e.g., shampoo, soap, cosmetics, etc.).
- Electronic devices and computers. Wifi is available in all of MBC's buildings.
- Pictures, posters, wall hangings, knick-knacks that help you feel at home. Please note we ask that you use non-damaging methods of hangers, such as Command strips.
- Washers and dryers are provided (free of charge) in the dorm laundry rooms. Students will need to supply detergent, dryer sheets, laundry basket, etc.
- Study atmosphere enhancers: desks are provided in each bedroom, but you may want a lamp, desk organizer, etc.
- Clothing and outdoor gear: warm and cold weather clothing, shoes and boots, hangers, etc. You may also bring outdoor gear if you have it (i.e. skis, snowboard, etc.)
- More important than anything else: genuine love for God and a heart to serve Him by serving your roommates!

This is not an exhaustive list, but it does give you a general idea of what you'll need to bring with you to your apartment. Bozeman does have Wal-Mart, Target, and several other discount stores (and thrift stores, too!), so anything not brought can be purchased here.
